1. APS, Babina was opened in Jul 1981 with an aim to provide quality education to the wards of serving & retired defence personnel including civilians paid out of defence estimate. The school has classes from Balvatika to XII & is affiliated to CBSE. The first batch of class X passed out in the year 1998 & First batch of class XII passed out in the year 2000. The school has 1430 Children from Balvatika I to XII & has a teaching staff of 67 teachers. APS, Babina Cantt was taken over by HQ 27 Armd Bde on 23 Jan 2023. Continuous endeavours are being made by the School & Management Committee to improve standards including infrastructure and studies of school. To ensure this, regular interaction with the APS staff is being done.

3. The detls of activities carried out for the month of Jan 2025 are highlighted below:-

(a) **Witnessing the 3 Guards 250 years Raising Day Parade:** On 10Jan 2025 the senior students had the exceptional opportunity to attend the 250th Raising Day Parade of the 3 Guards Unit. The highlight of the event was undoubtedly the performance by the motorcycle stunt team. Dare Devils The thrilling manoeuvres, including precision riding and breath-taking stunts left the audience in awe. The students were particularly impressed by the high level of skill and teamwork displayed by the riders.

Another spectacular aspect of the parade was the paramotor demonstration. It provided both a visual treat and a lesson in courage and discipline. The students expressed their admiration for the bravery and training required for such daring feats.

Finally, the traditional band display accompanied by a synchronised march past was a testament to the unity and pride within the army.



(b) **District Olympics Champions Tournament.** On 11Jan 2025, we had our remarkable students from grade 9 and 11 participating in the district Olympics Champions Tournament held at Major Dhyanchand Stadium, Jhansi. The event showcased their talent and dedication and we are proud to announce that our students excelled in various track and field events bringing home multiple medals. The enthusiasm and sportsmanship displayed by the participants were inspiring and their success has brought pride to our school.



(c) **International Social Studies Olympiad.** On 23 Jan 2025, the Social Studies Olympiad was organised for students of various grade levels. The event aimed to enhance students' knowledge in social studies and promote critical thinking.



(d) **Army Day Celebration 2025.** On 15 Jan 2025, there was an event which was specially organised for the senior students, providing them with an opportunity to witness various military equipment, including weapons, guns and tanks. Students were given a close-up view of the tanks and weapons and they were also explained the specifications, capabilities and roles of these equipment's in modern warfare.



(e) **Pre-Board Exam –III and Board exam Practical.** The academic rigor continued with the commencement of the Pre-Board Examination-III and Board exam Practical. Spanning from 20th Jan –30th Jan 2025 for Pre-Boards and 9thJan - 14Feb 2025 for the Practical exam, these assessments served as a crucial benchmark to evaluate the preparedness and conceptual understanding of students and to also get them into the required mind set for their board exams.



(f) **Visit to ECHS Jhansi.** The students of class IX and XI visited the ECHS hospital Jhansi on Jan 16 2025. This trip was an enriching experience for our students, providing them with valuable insights into the working of a polyclinic facility. During the visit, students were warmly welcomed by the staff and taken on a comprehensive tour of the facility. The students were enthusiastic and engaged throughout the visit, actively participating in discussions and asking thoughtful questions.



(g) **Planetary Observation.** On Jan 25 2025 students of class IX to XII gathered at our playground to observe a remarkable astronomical phenomenon, the planetary parade. Under the guidance of Rahul Yadav and in collaboration with the 50 Armd Rgt, students were provided with the opportunity to view the alignment of celestial bodies through a telescope. The students had the unique opportunity to observe 6 planets during the event. The event fostered a spirit of inquiry among the students as they asked questions and discussed their observation with one another.



(h) **PTM for Class X and XII .** The PTM for class X and XII was held on 5th Feb 2025. The PTM was an opportunity for parents teachers and students to come together and discuss a detailed analysis of each students' performance .The teachers also discussed all the strategies the school would employ to support the students in their preparation for the board exams.
