1. APS, Babina was opened in Jul 1981 with an aim to provide quality education to the wards of serving & retired defence personnel including civilians paid out of defence estimate. The school has classes from Balvatika to XII & is affiliated to CBSE. The first batch of class X passed out in the year 1998 & First batch of class XII passed out in the year 2000. The school has 1141 Children from Balvatika I to XII & has a teaching staff of 67 teachers. APS, Babina Cantt was taken over by HQ 27 ArmdBde on 23 Jan 2023. Continuous endeavours are being made by the School & Management Committee to improve standards including infrastructure and studies of school. To ensure this, regular interaction with the APS staff is being done.


Scope

3. The detls of activities carried out for the month of June 2025 are highlighted below:-

(a) **Teacher's Training Workshop:** Teachers' Training Workshops were organized to enhance teaching skills and classroom management techniques. Educators conducted interactive sessions on innovative teaching methods, use of technology, and student engagement strategies. The workshop provided a valuable platform for professional growth and collaboration among teachers, aiming to improve the overall learning experience for students. Diverse topics were covered like Capacity building for educators, NEP-2020, UDISE plus, sharing school best practices and science around us and other important topics over a period of nine days.



(b) **International Yoga day Celebration**: Our school celebrated **International Yoga Day** with great enthusiasm on June 21st. Students and teachers gathered early in the morning for a group yoga session. Guided by our instructors, everyone performed various **asanas** and **pranayama** exercises. The event highlighted the importance of yoga in promoting physical health and mental well-being reminding us all to adopt yoga as a regular part of our lives.





(c) **Extra classes for Class IX-XII:** To support academic excellence, our school has arranged **extra classes for students of Class IX to XII**. These sessions focus on strengthening core subjects, clearing doubts, and providing additional practice. Experienced teachers guide students through important topics to help them prepare effectively for their board examinations. The initiative ensures better understanding and improved performance.

(d) **Farewell for outgoing and retiring teachers:** The teachers bid a heartfelt farewell to their colleagues — **Mr. Rajesh Saxena**, Librarian, dedicated **27 years** of service to the school; **Mrs. Farah Zunebia**, PGT (English) is leaving due to a transfer; and **Mr. Harimohan Purohit**, TGT (Hindi), has completed his tenure. It was an emotional moment as the entire staff of **APS Babina** came together to extend their best wishes and express their gratitude. The **Principal** appreciated all three teachers for their dedicated service and valuable contributions to the school.





(e) **Cluster Level Hindi Debate Competition.** Our school participated in Cluster Level Hindi Debate Competition held at APS Jhansi. Students participated with utmost sincerity and performed well with receiving appreciation from the judges. It was a great learning experience for the team.
